To Active Grantees of Special Permits: DOT-SP 8554, DOT-SP 10571,
DOT-SP 11579 and DOT-SP 12677:

Based on the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration's August 14, 2009, Show Cause Letter to the grantees of DOT-SP 8554, DOT-SP 10571, DOT-SP 11579 and DOT-SP 12677 these special permits have been modified by incorporating revisions or new provision to the:

- Driver Qualification and Training Requirements;
- Vehicle Construction Standards;
- Tire Standards;
- Emergency Response Requirements; and
- Accident Reporting Requirements.

In accordance with 49 CFR § 107.123, a special permit holder affected by a modification, suspension or termination of a special permit may seek reconsideration by filing a request with the Associate Administrator within 20 days of receipt of the decision. That request must conform to the requirements found in section 107.123(a).
