Dear Mr. Humbert:

This is in reply to your letter of March 26, 1971, concerning a request for interpretation of Section 192.743 of the Minimum Federal Safety Standards for Transportation of Natural and Other Gas by Pipeline, and its application to meter settings where gas is being measured as well as regulated.

This section applies to all pressure limiting and regulating stations whether or not they are located in combination with other equipment or regardless of their type of service.

As required by the regulation, you must either test or review each relieving device at the specified interval.
