Re: Enbridge Line 6B Pipeline Incident near MP 608
Request for PHMSA Written Notice to Restart Line 6B

Dear Mr. Barrett:

In response to the release on the Enbridge Line 6B pipeline near Milepost ("MP") 608 approximately one mile south of Marshall, Michigan, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration ("PHMSA") issued a Corrective Action Order ("CAO") on July 28, 2010, as amended September 22, 2010.

Enbridge submitted its Restart Plan for Line 6B ("Restart Plan") for consideration and approval by PHMSA on September 21, 2010. On September 22, 2010 Enbridge received the final amended CAO and PHMSA's approval of the Restart Plan. The approval outlines additional steps PHMSA requires Enbridge to complete prior to the regulator approving Line 6B's return to service.

The purpose of this letter is to advise PHMSA of the completion of the additional measures identified in the September 22, 2010 Restart Plan approval letter, as follows:

- Enbridge provided written notice to affected communities and local responders along the entire length of Line 6B on September 23, 2010.
- Enbridge provided written notice to affected public and emergency responders throughout its Lakehead Pipeline System, to reinforce public awareness and emergency response messaging.
- In addition to the written notice, Enbridge directly contacted emergency responders in Calhoun, Kalamazoo and St. Clair, Michigan Counties.
- Enbridge notified the Kalamazoo River / Enbridge Oil Spill Response Unified Command of its intent to restart Line 6B on September 27, 2010.

Enbridge has completed planning and preparations required to facilitate and enable PHMSA's third party consultant to monitor and verify that Enbridge restarts Line 6B in accordance with the PHMSA approved Restart Plan and is in a position to return Line 6B to service the morning of Monday, Sept. 27, subject to its receipt of final PHMSA approval.

Enbridge, thereby requests PHMSA's written notice to restart Line 6B in accordance with these plans and the operating parameters set forth in the Restart Plan.
