Special Permit Renewal from April 15, 2015 to April 15, 2020

Dear Mr. Ramsey:

By letter dated August 14, 2014, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS) notified Northern Natural Gas Company (Northern) that special permit (PHMSA-2006-26614) would expire on April 15, 2015, unless renewed. By letter dated October 3, 2014, and supplemented by additional correspondence, Northern applied for the renewal of the special permit, PHMSA-2006-26614, and provided operational documents to justify the special permit renewal. On February 4, 2015, PHMSA published a Federal Register notice announcing the renewal request (80 FR 6174). No public comments were received.

The special permit segment is approximately eight (8) miles in length on the Northern 3½-inch St. Joseph Pipeline (MNB64101) and located in Benton and Stearns Counties, Minnesota. This special permit allows for the non-odorization of natural gas in a pipeline that is normally required to be odorized in accordance with 49 CFR § 192.625(b)(1).

The special permit renewal request letter and all other pertinent documents are available for review in Docket No. PHMSA-2006-26614 in the Federal Docket Management System (FDMS) located at www.regulations.gov.


PHMSA reviewed all operational, maintenance, and environmental assessment data submitted by Northern for the 3½-inch St. Joseph Pipeline (MNB64101) special permit. PHMSA finds that Northern continues to meet the terms of the special permit and there has been no material change in conditions. Based on the information provided by Northern, PHMSA has determined that renewal of the special permit would not be inconsistent with pipeline safety.

Accordingly, by this Order, and as described in the original special permit, PHMSA grants Northern Natural Gas Company a special permit renewal for PHMSA-2006-26614, to operate the Northern 3½-inch St. Joseph Pipeline (MNB64101) located in Benton and Stearns Counties, Minnesota, from April 15, 2015, through April 15, 2020. This special permit renewal Order waives compliance with 49 CFR § 192.625(b)(1) for the Northern 3½-inch St. Joseph Pipeline (MNB64101).
