Committee Action on Notice of Proposed Rulemaking & Regulatory Evaluation

Sample Language to Call a Motion

Committee Action: On December 13, 2010, the Technical Hazardous Liquid Pipeline Safety Standards Committee (THLPSSC) will consider the notice of proposed rulemaking (NPRM) and the draft regulatory evaluation for the following:

“Pipeline Safety: Applying Safety Regulation to All Rural Onshore Hazardous Liquid Low-Stress Lines” published in the *Federal Register* on June 22, 2010 (75 FR 35366)

Report: The committee’s vote and the meeting transcript constitute the report described in each Committee Charter under “Committee Objectives and Scope of Activities.” Each report is a permanent record of the meeting and filed in the official docket.

Calling a motion: The following is sample language to call a motion:

1. ___ The proposed rule as published in the *Federal Register* and the Draft Regulatory Evaluation are technically feasible, reasonable, cost-effective, and practicable.
2. ___ The proposed rule as published in the *Federal Register* and the Draft Regulatory Evaluation are technically feasible, reasonable, cost-effective, and practicable if the following changes are made (members insert language of proposed change).
3. ___ The proposed rule as published in the *Federal Register* and the Draft Regulatory Evaluation are not (or cannot be made) technically feasible, reasonable, cost-effective and practicable.

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
