Dear Mr. Goodwin:

The Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) reviewed your letter of January 27, 2014, with regards to Special Permit No. PHMSA-2007-0039, originally granted on February 27, 2009. Pursuant to Condition 26 of the special permit, Gulf South Pipeline Company, LP (Gulf South) gave notice of its intention to extend the original Segment 3 on the 30-inch TPL-800 pipeline located in Mobile County, Alabama, by 309 feet. This extension is within the limits of the existing special permit inspection area.

The Extended PHMSA-2007-0039 Special Permit Segment is now defined as:

Special Permit Segment	Mile Post	Length
Segment 3 TPL-880	Survey Station 699+77 to Survey Station 704+67	490 feet

Under the terms of the revised special permit PHMSA-2007-0039, Gulf South must complete all inspections and remediation of the extended Segment 3 TPL-800 as was required for all of the TPL-880 segments in the original special permit.
