Your March 29, 2005 application for exemption (14191-N) is returned herewith because it failed to meet the requirements of 49 CFR 107.105 for the following reason:

Your application did not demonstrate a level of safety that is at least equal to that required by the HMR (see § 107.105(d)). Specifically, an exemption from the provisions of 49 CFR 172.400a to authorize use of the CGA label (1 inch x 1 inch) on full size packages other than cylinders would not provide for a level of safety equivalent to that provided by the existing regulations and is not in the public interest.
