DOT-E 10302

- 1. Austin Powder Company, Cleveland, Ohio is hereby granted an emergency exemption from certain provisions of this Department's Hazardous Materials Regulations to offer packages of a high explosive for transportation in commerce subject to the limitations and special requirements specified herein. This exemption authorizes shipments of trinitrotoluene (TNT), Class A explosive, in packages which are labeled in accordance with IMO regulations rather than DOT regulations and provides no relief from any regulation other than as specifically stated.
- 2. <u>BASIS</u>. This exemption is based on Austin Powder Company's application dated December 20, 1989 submitted in accordance with 49 CFR 107.113 based on a protection of life and property.
- 3. <u>HAZARDOUS MATERIALS (Descriptor and class)</u>. Trinitrotoluene (TNT), classed as class A explosive.
- 4. PROPER SHIPPING NAME (49 CFR 172.101). High explosive.
- 5. RECULATION AFFECTED. 49 CFR 171.12 (d), 172.411(a).
- MODES OF TRANSPORTATION AUTHORIZED. Motor vehicle and cargo vessel.
- 7. SAFETY CONTROL MEASURES. Packagings must be transported in closed motor vehicles from port-of-entry to final destination.
- 8. SPECIAL PROVISIONS.
 - a. A copy of this exemption must be carried on each motor vehicle used to transport packages covered by this exemption.
 - b. Labels on packages may be as specified in IMO's IMDG Code rather than as specified in 49 CFR, Part 172.
 - c. Placarding must be as specified for Explosives A in 49 CFR, Part 172.
- 9. <u>REPORTING REQUIREMENTS</u>. Any incident involving a fire, explosion, or loss of contents of the package must be reported to the Office of Hazardous Materials Transportation as soon as practicable.
