1. GRANTEE: Maine Department of Transportation  
(Maine State Ferry Service)  
Augusta, ME
2. PURPOSE AND LIMITATION:
  - a. This special permit authorizes the transportation in commerce of propane and liquefied petroleum gas in DOT Specification cylinders, carried in transport vehicles, or DOT Specification cargo tanks on passenger ferry vessels. This special permit provides no relief from the Hazardous Materials Regulations (HMR) other than as specifically stated herein. The most recent revision supersedes all previous revisions.
  - b. The safety analyses performed in development of this special permit only considered the hazards and risks associated with transportation in commerce.
  - c. Party status will not be granted to this special permit.
3. REGULATORY SYSTEM AFFECTED: 49 CFR Parts 106, 107 and 171-180.
4. REGULATIONS FROM WHICH EXEMPTED: 49 CFR § 172.101(k)(5) in that carriage aboard passenger ferry vessel is authorized and § 172.301(c) and 172.302(c) in that the marking requirements are waived, as specified herein.
5. BASIS: This special permit is based on the application of Maine Department of Transportation (Maine State Ferry Service) dated February 18, 2025, submitted in accordance with § 107.109.

7. SAFETY CONTROL MEASURES: Packagings must be DOT Specification cylinders that comply with § 173.304a or DOT Specification cargo tanks that comply with § 173.315.

8. SPECIAL PROVISIONS: None.

9. MODES OF TRANSPORTATION AUTHORIZED: Passenger ferry vessel.

10. MODAL REQUIREMENTS:

a. Carriage of a transport vehicle carrying propane or petroleum gases, liquefied contained in DOT Specification cylinders having water capacity not exceeding 100 pounds or DOT Specification cargo tanks on board a passenger ferry vessel is permitted subject to the following conditions:

(1) The transport vehicle must be stowed only on the open weather deck in a location acceptable to the Captain of the Port, taking into account the proximity to spaces occupied by passengers and the need to provide physical protection of the vehicle and its lading.

(2) If practical, the transport vehicle must be loaded onto and unloaded from the passenger ferry vessel either prior to or after the loading and unloading of other vehicles.

(3) The vessel operator must ensure that the transport vehicle is under regular surveillance by a member of the crew.

(4) Passengers, other than the vehicle operator, may not remain in the vicinity of the transport vehicle carrying these materials.

(5) Arrangements must be made to provide for rapid response to a casualty or fire involving the transport vehicle or its lading. If weather and other conditions permit, a charged fire hose must be laid out in the vicinity of the transport vehicle.

(6) All applicable provisions of Part 176, including those contained in § 176.76 and 176.89 must be observed.

b. Compliance with the above provisions and any additional provisions must be to the satisfaction of the Captain of the Port.

c. A current copy of this special permit must be carried on board each passenger ferry vessel used to transport the hazardous materials covered by this special permit.

11. COMPLIANCE: Failure by a person to comply with any of the following may result in suspension or revocation of this special permit and penalties prescribed by the Federal hazardous materials transportation law, 49 U.S.C. 5101 et seq:

- o All terms and conditions prescribed in this special permit and the Hazardous Materials Regulations, 49 CFR Parts 171-180.
- o Persons operating under the terms of this special permit must comply with the security plan requirement in Subpart I of Part 172 of the HMR, when applicable.
- o Registration required by § 107.601 et seq., when applicable.

Each “Hazmat employee”, as defined in § 171.8 who performs a function subject to this special permit must receive training on the requirements and conditions of this special permit in addition to the training required by §§ 172.700 through 172.704.

No person may use or apply this special permit, including display of its number, when the special permit has expired or is otherwise no longer in effect.

Under Title VII of the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU) --- “The Hazardous Materials Safety and Security Reauthorization Act of 2005” (Pub. L. 109-59), 119 Stat. 1144 (August 10, 2005), amended the Federal hazardous materials transportation law by changing the term “exemption” to “special permit” and authorizes a special permit to be granted up to two years for new special permits and up to four years for renewals.

12. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS: Shipments or operations conducted under this special permit are subject to the Hazardous Materials Incident Reporting requirements specified in 49 CFR §§ 171.15 - Immediate notice of certain hazardous materials incidents, and 171.16 - Detailed hazardous materials incident reports. In addition, the grantee(s) of this special permit must notify the Associate Administrator for Hazardous Materials Safety, in writing, of any incident involving a package, shipment or operation conducted under terms of this special permit.
