1. GRANTEE: Union Pacific Railroad Company, Omaha, Nebraska
2. PURPOSE AND LIMITATION: This exemption authorizes the shipment of a DOT Specification 112T340W tank car, containing a Division 2.1 material, meeting all DOT requirements except that the tank car is not equipped with a complete thermal insulation system due to an accident. This exemption provides no relief from any regulations other than as specifically stated.
3. REGULATORY SYSTEM AFFECTED: 49 CFR Parts 106, 107 and 171-180.
4. REGULATIONS FROM WHICH EXEMPTED: 49 CFR 173.31(a); 173.314(c); and 179.105-4.
5. BASIS. This exemption is based on Union Pacific Railroad Company's application of August 10, 1994, and additional information dated September 22, 1994, submitted in accordance with 49 CFR 107.105.

7. PACKAGING(S) and SAFETY CONTROL MEASURES:

- a. PACKAGING - Packaging prescribed is a DOT specification 112T340W tank car, PSPX 32009, with an incomplete thermal protection system.
- b. MARKING - Tank car PSPX 32009 must be marked "DOT-E 11303" in four inch letters on a contrasting background above the DOT Specification number.

8. SPECIAL PROVISIONS.

a. Shipment of tank car PSPX 32009 is authorized from Union Pacific Railroad Company's Yard, Ogden, Utah, to Phillips 66 Refinery, Woods Cross, Utah, a distance of approximately 30 miles utilizing the most direct route available via the Union Pacific Railroad Company and when emptied from Phillips 66 Refinery, Woods Cross, Utah, to Phillips 66, Elkhart, Texas, a distance of approximately 1913 miles utilizing the most direct route available via Union Pacific Railroad Company and Denver & Rio Grande Industries.

b. Persons who receive packages covered by this exemption may reoffer them for transportation provided no modifications or changes are made to the packages, all terms of this exemption are complied with, and a current copy of this exemption is maintained at each facility from which such reoffering occurs.

9. MODES OF TRANSPORTATION AUTHORIZED. Rail freight.

11. COMPLIANCE. Failure by a person to comply with any of the following may result in suspension or revocation of this exemption and penalties prescribed by the Federal hazardous materials transportation law, 49 U.S.C. 5101 et seq.:


- All terms and conditions prescribed in this exemption and the Hazardous Materials Regulations, Parts 171-180.
- Registration required by 49 CFR 107.601 et seq., when applicable.

No person may use or apply this exemption, including display of its number, when the exemption has expired or is otherwise no longer in effect unless a regulation has been amended making the exemption no longer necessary.

12. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS. The carrier is required to report any incident involving loss of packaging contents or packaging failure to the Associate Administrator for Hazardous Materials Safety as soon as practicable. (49 CFR 171.15 and 171.16 apply to any activity undertaken under the authority of this exemption.)
