To All Grantees of DOT-SP 12842:

This is in response to your application for party status to DOT-SP 12842, which authorizes the transportation in commerce of certain Division 2.1 and Division 2.2 materials in aerosol cans contained in strong outer packages with a gross mass not to exceed 500 kg to a recycling or disposal facility.

In accordance with 49 C.F.R. § 107.113(e) and (g), your application is denied for the following reason:

This special permit is no longer necessary. The provisions of DOT-SP 12842 were incorporated into the Hazardous Materials Regulations under Docket No. HM-233A in a final rule published in the Federal Register on May 14, 2010 (75 FR 27205). This authority is now contained in 49 C.F.R. § 173.306(k) and became effective October 1, 2010. You may request reconsideration of this decision within 20 days of receipt of this decision. In accordance with 49 C.F.R. § 107.123 a request for reconsideration must:

- 3) Enclose any additional information needed to support the request; and
- 4) State in detail the modification of the final decision sought.
