1. GRANTEE: Department of Defense

2. PURPOSE AND LIMITATION:
 - a. This special permit authorizes the transportation in commerce of Division 1.2E explosives in non-DOT specification packagings under the terms and conditions contained within. This special permit provides no relief from the Hazardous Materials Regulations (HMR), International Civil Aviation Organization's Technical Instructions for the Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air (ICAO TI), or the International Maritime Dangerous Goods (IMDG) Code other than as specifically stated herein. The most recent revision supersedes all previous revisions.

 - b. The safety analyses performed in the development of this special permit only considered the hazards and risks associated with the transportation in commerce.

 - c. No party status will be granted to this special permit.

3. REGULATORY SYSTEM AFFECTED: 49 CFR Parts 106, 107 and 171-180, the ICAO TI, and the IMDG Code.

4. REGULATIONS FROM WHICH EXEMPTED: 49 CFR 173.62, in that a non-DOT specification package is not authorized and § 172.101 Column (9B) in that explosives listed in paragraph 6 are forbidden by cargo aircraft only, except as provided herein. When conforming to the terms of this special permit, shipments need not comply with the prohibition for transport aboard aircraft in columns 10 through 13 of 3;2, Table 3-1 of the ICAO TI and with the Packing Instruction P130 of the IMDG Code requirement that UN-standard packaging is used, except as provided herein.

5. BASIS: This special permit is based on the application of U.S. Department of the Army dated April 28, 2023, submitted in accordance with § 107.109.

7. PACKAGING: Prescribed packaging is a steel container with interior polyethylene cushioning (comparable to a UN4A1 container, except the maximum weight exceeds 400 Kg, (882 lbs.)), which has been tested in accordance with procedures contained in Test Report Number 43777-1, dated December 5, 1977, on file with the Office of Hazardous Materials Safety. Specific packaging instructions are contained in Certification of equivalency AF 83-211, which must accompany this special permit.
8. SPECIAL PROVISIONS: A current copy of this special permit must be maintained at each facility where the package is offered or reoffered for transportation.
9. MODES OF TRANSPORTATION AUTHORIZED: Motor vehicle, rail freight, cargo vessel, and cargo-only aircraft.
10. MODAL REQUIREMENTS: A current copy of this special permit must be carried aboard each cargo vessel, cargo only aircraft, or motor vehicle used to transport packages covered by this special permit.
11. COMPLIANCE: Failure by a person to comply with any of the following may result in suspension or revocation of this special permit and penalties prescribed by the Federal hazardous materials transportation law, 49 U.S.C. 5101 et seq:
 - o All terms and conditions prescribed in this special permit and the Hazardous Materials Regulations, 49 CFR Parts 171-180.
 - o Persons operating under the terms of this special permit must comply with the security plan requirement in Subpart I of Part 172 of the HMR, when applicable.
 - o Registration required by § 107.601 et seq., when applicable.

Each "Hazmat employee", as defined in § 171.8, who performs a function subject to this special permit must receive training on the requirements and conditions of this special permit in addition to the training required by §§ 172.700 through 172.704.

No person may use or apply this special permit, including display of its number, when this special permit has expired or is otherwise no longer in effect.

Under Title VII of the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU) — “The Hazardous Materials Safety and Security Reauthorization Act of 2005” (Pub. L. 109-59), 119 Stat. 1144 (August 10, 2005), amended the Federal hazardous materials transportation law by changing the term “exemption” to “special permit” and authorizes a special permit to be granted up to two years for new special permits and up to four years for renewals.

12. **REPORTING REQUIREMENTS:** Shipments or operations conducted under this special permit are subject to the Hazardous Materials Incident Reporting requirements specified in 49 CFR §§ 171.15 - Immediate notice of certain hazardous materials incidents, and 171.16 - Detailed hazardous materials incident reports. In addition, the grantee(s) of this special permit must notify the Associate Administrator for Hazardous Materials Safety, in writing, of any incident involving a package, shipment or operation conducted under terms of this special permit.
