1. GRANTEE: Veolia ES Technical Solutions LLC
Lombard, IL
2. PURPOSE AND LIMITATION:
 - a. This special permit to authorize the one-time, one-way transportation of unapproved explosives by motor vehicle. This special permit provides no relief from the Hazardous Materials Regulations (HMR) other than as specifically stated herein. The most recent revision supersedes all previous revisions.
 - b. The safety analyses performed in the development of this special permit only considered the hazards and risks associated with the transportation in commerce.
 - c. Unless otherwise stated herein, this special permit consists of the special permit authorization letter issued to the grantee together with this document.
 - c. No party status will be granted to this special permit.
3. REGULATORY SYSTEM AFFECTED: 49 CFR Parts 106, 107 and 171-180.
4. REGULATIONS FROM WHICH EXEMPTED: 49 CFR § 173.21(b) in that offering forbidden explosives is not authorized and §§ 173.51, 173.54(a), and 173.56(b) in that explosives must be tested, classed, and approved, except as specified herein.
5. BASIS: This special permit is based on the application of

6. HAZARDOUS MATERIALS (49 CFR 172.101):

*Only fireworks described in the application dated May 24, 2016 and on file with the Office of Hazardous Materials Safety Approvals and Permits Division may be transported under the terms of this special permit.

7. SAFETY CONTROL MEASURES:

a. PACKAGING - The fireworks devices shall be packaged in accordance with Packing Instruction 135 as listed in the §173.62 Table of Packing Methods.

b. OPERATIONAL CONTROLS -

- (1) The carrier must hold a valid Hazmat Safety Permit as issued by the Federal Motor Carrier Administration.
- (2) Waste transportation shall be directly from the Aberdeen Proving Ground military facility located in Aberdeen, Maryland to the Clean Harbors thermal treatment facility in Colfax, LA.
- (3) Transportation must be completed in the shortest time-frame possible while at all times adhering to all federal, state and local regulations relative to the operation of a commercial motor vehicle on a public highway. To the extent possible, transportation will be conducted so as to avoid rush-hour traffic and avoid high density traffic.
- (4) Transportation must be conducted on highways and avoid residential areas to the extent possible.

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- (5) While in transportation, the cargo carrying portion of the vehicle shall be locked and secured at all times.
- (6) The carrier shall transport the loaded vehicle only to the Clean Harbors, Colfax, LA thermal treatment facility without any unnecessary delays and in conformance with the enroute procedures as specified in the carrier's transportation security plan.
- (7) No type of oxidizer, fuel, flammable solid or combustible device or item will be transported in the same motor vehicle as packages covered under the terms of the special permit.
- (8) The appropriate PHMSA Safety Regional Office must be notified at least 48 hours in advance of any shipment.
- (9) A statement must be provided to the Office of Hazardous Materials Safety Approvals and Permits Division when the shipment arrives at the Clean Harbors thermal treatment facility located in Colfax, LA.

8. SPECIAL PROVISIONS:

a. A person who is not a holder of this special permit who receives a package covered by this special permit may reoffer it for transportation provided no modification or change is made to the package or its contents and it is reoffered for transportation in conformance with this special permit and the HMR.

b. A current copy of this special permit must be maintained at each facility where the package is offered or reoffered for transportation.

9. MODES OF TRANSPORTATION AUTHORIZED: Motor Vehicle.

10. MODAL REQUIREMENTS: A current copy of this special permit must be carried aboard each motor vehicle used to transport packages covered by this special permit.

11. COMPLIANCE: Failure by a person to comply with any of the following may result in suspension or revocation of this

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special permit and penalties prescribed by the Federal hazardous materials transportation law, 49 U.S.C. 5101 et seq:

- o All terms and conditions prescribed in this special permit and the Hazardous Materials Regulations, 49 CFR Parts 171-180.
- o Persons operating under the terms of this special permit must comply with the security plan requirement in Subpart I of Part 172 of the HMR, when applicable.
- o Registration required by § 107.601 et seq., when applicable.

Each "Hazmat employee", as defined in § 171.8, who performs a function subject to this special permit must receive training on the requirements and conditions of this special permit in addition to the training required by §§ 172.700 through 172.704.

No person may use or apply this special permit, including display of its number, when this special permit has expired or is otherwise no longer in effect.

Under Title VII of the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU)—"The Hazardous Materials Safety and Security Reauthorization Act of 2005" (Pub. L. 109-59), 119 Stat. 1144 (August 10, 2005), amended the Federal hazardous materials transportation law by changing the term "exemption" to "special permit" and authorizes a special permit to be granted up to two years for new special permits and up to four years for renewals.

12. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS: Shipments or operations conducted under this special permit are subject to the Hazardous Materials Incident Reporting requirements specified in 49 CFR §§ 171.15 - Immediate notice of certain hazardous

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materials incidents, and 171.16 - Detailed hazardous materials incident reports. In addition, the grantee(s) of this special permit must notify the Associate Administrator for Hazardous Materials Safety, in writing, of any incident involving a package, shipment or operation conducted under terms of this special permit.
