1. <u>GRANTEE</u>: Northrop Grumman Systems Corporation Beltsville, MD

# 2. PURPOSE AND LIMITATION:

- a. This special permit authorizes the transportation in commerce of hazardous materials over 422 feet of public roadways without being subject to the HMR. This special permit provides no relief from the Hazardous Materials Regulations (HMR) other than as specifically stated herein. The most recent revision supersedes all previous revisions.
- b. The safety analyses performed in the development of this special permit only considered the hazards and risks associated with the transportation in commerce.
- c. No party status will be granted to this special permit.
- 3. REGULATORY SYSTEM AFFECTED: 49 CFR Parts 106, 107 and 171-180.
- 4. REGULATIONS FROM WHICH EXEMPTED: 49 CFR § 172.300, 400 and 500 in that marking, labeling and placarding requirements of the HMR are waived, 177.817(c)(1) in that shipping papers are required, 172.602(c)(1) in that emergency response information must be maintained in the same manner as prescribed for shipping papers and § 172.604(a)(3) in that an emergency response telephone number must be entered on a shipping paper.

5. <u>BASIS</u>: This special permit is based on the application of Northrop Grumman Systems Corporation dated October 28, 2024, submitted in accordance with § 107.109.

# 7. <u>SAFETY CONTROL MEASURES</u>:

a. <u>PACKAGING</u>: as required by the HMR.

# b. <u>OPERATIONAL CONTROLS</u>:

- (1) Transportation is only authorized along either of two routes identified in ATK Space System's application dated November 26, 2019.
- (2) Shipment preparation will be conducted by hazmat trained employees of Northrop Grumman Systems Corporation.
- (3) In lieu of a shipping paper the operator of the motor vehicle will possess a document or a list of the hazardous materials with the quantities of each hazardous material.
- (4) The motor vehicle transporting hazardous materials under the terms of this SP will have an Emergency Response Guidebook (ERG) in the vehicle.

- (5) In the event of an emergency the motor vehicle operator transporting the hazardous materials will have a means of communication such as a radio or mobile phone during the carriage of the hazardous materials under the terms of this SP.
- (6) The driver of the motor vehicle will be a trained HAZMAT employee.

### 8. SPECIAL PROVISIONS:

- a. A person who is not a holder of this special permit who receives a package covered by this special permit may reoffer it for transportation provided no modification or change is made to the package or its contents and it is reoffered for transportation in conformance with this special permit and the HMR.
- b. A current copy of this special permit must be maintained at each facility where the package is offered or reoffered for transportation.
- 9. MODES OF TRANSPORTATION AUTHORIZED: Motor vehicle.
- 10. <u>MODAL REQUIREMENTS</u>: A current copy of this special permit must be carried aboard each motor vehicle used to transport packages covered by this special permit.
- 11. <u>COMPLIANCE</u>: Failure by a person to comply with any of the following may result in suspension or revocation of this special permit and penalties prescribed by the Federal hazardous materials transportation law, 49 U.S.C. 5101 <u>et seq</u>:
  - o All terms and conditions prescribed in this special permit and the Hazardous Materials Regulations, 49 CFR Parts 171-180.
  - o Persons operating under the terms of this special permit must comply with the security plan requirement in Subpart I of Part 172 of the HMR, when applicable.
  - o Registration required by § 107.601 et seq., when applicable.

Each "Hazmat employee", as defined in § 171.8, who performs a function subject to this special permit must receive training on the requirements and conditions of this special permit in addition to the training required by §§ 172.700 through 172.704.

No person may use or apply this special permit, including display of its number, when this special permit has expired or is otherwise no longer in effect.

Under Title VII of the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU)—"The Hazardous Materials Safety and Security Reauthorization Act of 2005" (Pub. L. 109-59), 119 Stat. 1144 (August 10, 2005), amended the Federal hazardous materials transportation law by changing the term "exemption" to "special permit" and authorizes a special permit to be granted up to two years for new special permits and up to four years for renewals.

12. <u>REPORTING REQUIREMENTS</u>: Shipments or operations conducted under this special permit are subject to the Hazardous Materials Incident Reporting requirements specified in 49 CFR §§ 171.15 - Immediate notice of certain hazardous materials incidents, and 171.16 - Detailed hazardous materials incident reports. In addition, the grantee(s) of this special permit must notify the Associate Administrator for Hazardous Materials Safety, in writing, of any incident involving a package, shipment or operation conducted under terms of this special permit.
