1. <u>GRANTEE</u>: B/E Aerospace Inc.

2. PURPOSE AND LIMITATIONS:

- a. This special permit authorizes the transportation in commerce of certain fire extinguishers containing Division 2.2 gases in alternative outer packaging by aircraft. This special permit provides no relief from the Hazardous Materials Regulations (HMR) other than as specifically stated herein. The most recent revision supersedes all previous revisions.
- b. The safety analyses performed in development of this special permit only considered the hazards and risks associated with transportation in commerce. The safety analyses did not consider the hazards and risks associated with consumer use, use as a component of a transport vehicle or other device, or other uses not associated with transportation in commerce.
- c. No party status will be granted to this special permit.
- 3. REGULATORY SYSTEM AFFECTED: 49 CFR Parts 106, 107 and 171-180.
- 4. <u>REGULATIONS FROM WHICH EXEMPTED</u>: 49 CFR § 173.309(c)(5) in that a non-specification fire extinguisher must be packaged as an inner packaging within an alternative outer packaging.
- 5. <u>BASIS</u>: This special permit is based on the renewal application of B/E Aerospace Inc. dated March 28, 2024, submitted in accordance with § 107.109.

7. SAFETY CONTROL MEASURES:

a. <u>PACKAGING</u>: Prescribed packaging is a non-specification fire extinguisher installed in a fully completed lavatory (LAV) assembly. The lavatory assembly must be in accordance with the application on file with OHMS. The fire extinguisher must be in conformance with all requirements of 49 CFR 173.309(c) for non-specification cylinders except as follows:

§ 173.309(c)(5) * * *, except as follows:

Each fire extinguisher must be packaged as an inner packaging within the lavatory assembly.

- b. MARKING: The outside of each Package must be marked "DOT-SP 21306".
- c. <u>OPERATIONAL CONTROLS</u>: There must be one fire extinguisher per lavatory assembly. The fire extinguisher must be securely and permanently installed inside the waste receptacle of the lavatory and surrounded by composite sandwich panels. Each completed lavatory assembly must be securely mounted to a wooden pallet via screws and wrapped in protective shrink wrap.

8. SPECIAL PROVISIONS:

- a. A person who is not a holder of this special permit, but receives a packaging covered by this special permit, may reoffer it for transportation provided no modification or change is made to the packaging and it is offered for transportation in conformance with this special permit and the HMR.
- b. A current copy of this special permit must be maintained at each facility where the package is offered or reoffered for transportation.

- 9. <u>MODES OF TRANSPORTATION AUTHORIZED</u>: Cargo-only aircraft, passenger-carrying aircraft, rail freight, motor vehicle, and cargo vessel.
- 10. <u>MODAL REQUIREMENTS</u>: A current copy of this special permit must be carried aboard each cargo vessel, aircraft or motor vehicle used to transport packages covered by this special permit. The shipper must furnish a copy of this special permit to the air carrier before or at the time the shipment is tendered.
- 11. <u>COMPLIANCE</u>: Failure by a person to comply with any of the following may result in suspension or revocation of this special permit and penalties prescribed by the Federal hazardous materials transportation law, 49 U.S.C. 5101 et seq:
 - o All terms and conditions prescribed in this special permit and the Hazardous Materials Regulations, 49 CFR Parts 171-180.
 - o Persons operating under the terms of this special permit must comply with the security plan requirement in Subpart I of Part 172 of the HMR, when applicable.
 - o Registration required by § 107.601 et seq., when applicable.

Each "Hazmat employee", as defined in § 171.8, who performs a function subject to this special permit must receive training on the requirements and conditions of this special permit in addition to the training required by §§ 172.700 through 172.704.

No person may use or apply this special permit, including display of its number, when this special permit has expired or is otherwise no longer in effect.

Under Title VII of the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU) — "The Hazardous Materials Safety and Security Reauthorization Act of 2005" (Pub. L. 109-59), 119 Stat. 1144 (August 10, 2005), amended the Federal hazardous materials transportation law by changing the term "exemption" to "special permit" and authorizes a special permit to be granted up to two years for new special permits and up to four years for renewals.

12. <u>REPORTING REQUIREMENTS</u>: Shipments or operations conducted under this special permit are subject to the Hazardous Materials Incident Reporting requirements specified in 49 CFR §§ 171.15 - Immediate notice of certain hazardous materials incidents, and 171.16 - Detailed hazardous materials incident reports. In addition, the grantee(s) of this special permit must notify the Associate Administrator for Hazardous Materials Safety, in writing, of any incident involving a package, shipment or operation conducted under terms of this special permit.
