1. GRANTEE: (See individual authorization letter)
2. PURPOSE AND LIMITATION:
 - a. This special permit authorizes the transportation in commerce of beverages, food, cosmetics and medicines, medical screening solutions, and concentrates sold as retail products containing saturated linear or branched alcohols (except methanol) classed as a flammable liquid or a flammable solid containing saturated linear or branched alcohols (except methanol) as being excepted from the Hazardous Materials Regulations (HMR). This special permit provides no relief from the HMR other than as specifically stated herein. The most recent revision supersedes all previous revisions.
 - b. The safety analyses performed in the development of this special permit only considered the hazards and risks associated with the transportation in commerce.
 - c. Unless otherwise stated herein, this special permit consists of the special permit authorization letter issued to the grantee together with this document.
 - d. Party status to this special permit may only be granted to Amazon.com, Inc. and wholly owned subsidiaries, affiliates, and the third-party logistics service providers of Amazon.com, Inc. that utilize Amazon's hazardous materials classification system and customer fulfillment technologies in the Amazon Fulfillment Network.
3. REGULATORY SYSTEM AFFECTED: 49 CFR Parts 106, 107 and 171-180.
4. REGULATIONS FROM WHICH EXEMPTED: 49 CFR § 173.150(g)(1) and (2) in that other alcohols (except methanol) are authorized and the inner packaging volume capacity is not limited, except as described herein; and § 172.301(c) in that marking the special permit number is waived.

5. **BASIS:** This special permit is based on the application of Amazon.com, Inc. dated August 14, 2025, submitted in accordance with § 107.105 and the public proceeding thereon and additional information dated February 5, 2026.
6. **HAZARDOUS MATERIALS (49 CFR 172.101):**

*Alcohols must not contain any other functional groups and must not meet the definition of any other hazard class.

7. **PACKAGING AND SAFETY CONTROL MEASURES:**
- a. A flammable liquid or flammable solid containing not more than 70% alcohol by volume for liquids, by weight for solids must be packaged as follows:
- (1) For non-glass inner packagings:
 - (i) Liquids may not exceed 470 mL (0.125 gallons).
 - (ii) Solids containing alcohol may not exceed 450 grams (1 pound).
 - (2) For glass inner packagings:
 - (i) Liquids may not exceed 230 mL (0.063 gallons).
 - (ii) Solids containing alcohol may not exceed 220 grams (0.5 pounds).
 - (3) The net liquid contents of all inner packagings in any single outer packaging may not exceed 5.6 L (1.5 gallons). The net solid contents of all inner packagings in any single outer packaging may not exceed 15 kilograms (33

pounds). The gross weight of any single outer package shipped may not exceed 30 kilograms (66 pounds). Inner packagings must be secured and cushioned within the outer package to prevent breakage, leakage, and shifting.

- b. A flammable liquid or flammable solid containing more than 70% alcohol by volume for liquids, by weight for solids must be packaged as follows:
- (1) Inner packagings containing liquids may not exceed 230 mL (0.063 gallons).
 - (2) Inner packagings containing solids containing alcohol may not exceed 220 grams (0.5 pounds).
 - (3) The net liquid contents of all inner packagings in any single outer packaging may not exceed 5.6 L (1.5 gallons). The net solid contents of all inner packagings in any single outer packaging may not exceed 15 kilograms (33 pounds). The gross weight of any single outer package shipped may not exceed 30 kilograms (66 pounds). Inner packagings must be secured and cushioned within the outer package to prevent breakage, leakage, and shifting.
- c. When conforming to the terms of this special permit, beverages, food, cosmetics and medicines, medical screening solutions, and concentrates sold as retail products containing saturated linear or branched alcohols (except methanol) classed as a flammable liquid or flammable solid containing saturated linear or branched alcohols (except methanol) are excepted from the HMR.

8. SPECIAL PROVISIONS:

- a. A person who is not a holder of this special permit who receives a package covered by this special permit may reoffer it for transportation provided no modification or change is made to the package and it is reoffered for transportation in conformance with this special permit and the HMR.
- b. A current copy of this special permit must be maintained at the Amazon.com, Inc. corporate headquarters.
- c. This special permit may only be used by Amazon.com, Inc. and wholly owned subsidiaries, affiliates, and the third-party logistics service providers that utilize Amazon's hazardous materials classification system and customer fulfillment technologies in the Amazon Fulfillment Network; the special permit cannot be used by "third-party sellers" operating on Amazon's website. Third-party logistics providers must only use this special permit for Amazon shipments.

9. MODES OF TRANSPORTATION AUTHORIZED: Motor vehicle, rail freight, ferry vessel, cargo vessel, passenger-carrying aircraft, and cargo aircraft.
10. MODAL REQUIREMENTS: None as a requirement of this special permit.
11. COMPLIANCE: Failure by a person to comply with any of the following may result in suspension or revocation of this special permit and penalties prescribed by the Federal hazardous materials transportation law, 49 U.S.C. 5101 et seq:
 - o All terms and conditions prescribed in this special permit and the Hazardous Materials Regulations, 49 CFR Parts 171-180.
 - o Persons operating under the terms of this special permit must comply with the security plan requirement in Subpart I of Part 172 of the HMR, when applicable.
 - o Registration required by § 107.601 et seq., when applicable.

Each “Hazmat employee”, as defined in § 171.8, who performs a function subject to this special permit must receive training on the requirements and conditions of this special permit.

No person may use or apply this special permit, including display of its number, when this special permit has expired or is otherwise no longer in effect.

Under Title VII of the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU) — “The Hazardous Materials Safety and Security Reauthorization Act of 2005” (Pub. L. 109-59), 119 Stat. 1144 (August 10, 2005), amended the Federal hazardous materials transportation law by changing the term “exemption” to “special permit” and authorizes a special permit to be granted up to two years for new special permits and up to four years for renewals.

12. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS: Shipments or operations conducted under this special permit are subject to the Hazardous Materials Incident Reporting requirements specified in 49 CFR §§ 171.15 - Immediate notice of certain hazardous materials incidents, and 171.16 - Detailed hazardous materials incident reports. In addition, the grantee(s) of this

special permit must notify the Associate Administrator for Hazardous Materials Safety, in writing, of any incident involving a package, shipment or operation conducted under terms of this special permit.
