1. GRANTEE: Spire Missouri Inc.  
Saint Louis, MO
2. PURPOSE AND LIMITATION:
  - a. This special permit authorizes the transportation in commerce of UN3336, mercaptans, liquid, flammable, n.o.s. *or* mercaptan mixture, liquid, flammable, n.o.s. within non-specification non-bulk and bulk packagings permanently attached to trailers. This special permit provides no relief from the Hazardous Materials Regulations (HMR) other than as specifically stated herein. The most recent revision supersedes all previous revisions.
  - b. The safety analyses performed in the development of this special permit only considered the hazards and risks associated with the transportation in commerce.
  - c. No party status will be granted to this special permit.
3. REGULATORY SYSTEM AFFECTED: 49 CFR Parts 106, 107 and 171-180.
4. REGULATIONS FROM WHICH EXEMPTED: 49 CFR § 171.8 in that a portable tank must be a bulk packaging and must be designed primarily to be loaded onto, or on, or temporarily attached to a transport vehicle and equipped with skids, mountings, or accessories to facilitate handling of the tank by mechanical means; § 173.242(c) in that the tanks may be less than 119 gallons; § 177.834(h) in that the portable tank may be discharged without being removed from the vehicle; § 180.605(d) and (e) in that alternative methods are authorized as provided herein.
5. BASIS: This special permit is based on the application of Spire Missouri Inc. dated October 8, 2025, submitted in accordance with § 107.105 and the public proceeding thereon.

6. HAZARDOUS MATERIALS (49 CFR 172.101):

7. SAFETY CONTROL MEASURES:

a. PACKAGING: The packagings prescribed are seven ASME certified and tested non-bulk and bulk pressure vessels conforming to the information on file with the Office of Hazardous Materials Safety (OHMS). Additionally, the pressure vessels must meet Part 178 Subpart H specifications for UN “T7” Specification portable tanks except non-bulk tank capacities are authorized. These tanks are permanently mounted to trailers.

b. TESTING: The authorized packagings are required to be inspected and tested periodically in accordance with the intervals required by Part 180 Subpart G in accordance with the procedures and methods on file with OHMS.

c. OPERATIONAL CONTROLS:

(1) Portable tanks marked with the special permit number are authorized to be tested and inspected under the terms of the special permit. Prior to use of additional portable tanks, OHMS must be notified in writing.

(2) Portable tanks tested under the terms of the special permit must remain in dedicated service for the hazardous material as indicated in paragraph 6. of this special permit.

(3) Spire Missouri, Inc. personnel are authorized to perform the 2.5- or 5-year periodic inspection and test. Any personnel performing the 2.5- or 5-year periodic inspection and test must complete the recordkeeping forms on file with OHMS.

(4) All 2.5-year or 5-year periodic inspection and test records must be maintained at the Spire Missouri, Inc. headquarters. The records must be maintained as long as the portable tanks authorized by this special permit continue in service.

8. SPECIAL PROVISIONS:

- a. The grantee must be the shipper and carrier under the terms of this special permit.
- b. A person who is not a holder of this special permit who receives a package covered by this special permit may reoffer it for transportation provided no modification or change is made to the package and it is reoffered for transportation in conformance with this special permit and the HMR.
- c. A current copy of this special permit must be maintained at each facility where the package is offered or reoffered for transportation.

9. MODES OF TRANSPORTATION AUTHORIZED: Motor vehicle.

10. MODAL REQUIREMENTS: A current copy of this special permit must be carried aboard each motor vehicle used to transport packages covered by this special permit.

11. COMPLIANCE: Failure by a person to comply with any of the following may result in suspension or revocation of this special permit and penalties prescribed by the Federal hazardous materials transportation law, 49 U.S.C. 5101 et seq.:

- o All terms and conditions prescribed in this special permit and the Hazardous Materials Regulations, 49 CFR Parts 171-180.
- o Persons operating under the terms of this special permit must comply with the security plan requirement in Subpart I of Part 172 of the HMR, when applicable.
- o Registration required by § 107.601 et seq., when applicable.

Each “Hazmat employee”, as defined in § 171.8, who performs a function subject to this special permit must receive training on the requirements and conditions of this special permit in addition to the training required by §§ 172.700 through 172.704.

No person may use or apply this special permit, including display of its number, when this special permit has expired or is otherwise no longer in effect.

Under Title VII of the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU) —“The Hazardous Materials Safety and Security Reauthorization Act of 2005” (Pub. L. 109-59), 119 Stat. 1144 (August 10, 2005), amended the Federal hazardous materials transportation law by changing the term “exemption” to “special permit” and authorizes a special permit to be granted up to two years for new special permits and up to four years for renewals.

12. **REPORTING REQUIREMENTS:** Shipments or operations conducted under this special permit are subject to the Hazardous Materials Incident Reporting requirements specified in 49 CFR §§ 171.15 - Immediate notice of certain hazardous materials incidents, and 171.16 - Detailed hazardous materials incident reports. In addition, the grantee(s) of this special permit must notify the Associate Administrator for Hazardous Materials Safety, in writing, of any incident involving a package, shipment or operation conducted under terms of this special permit.
