Dear Mr. Coy:

On March 17, 2008, Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company, LLC (TGP) received notice of the granting of a special permit by the Pipelines and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) to operate Line 230B-200, the Niagara Spur Loop Line, at 877 psig in a Class Location 3 area near Lockport, New York.

On May 30, 2012, TGP received notice granting the continuation of the special permit, including an amendment to include an additional contiguous segment.

Please be advised that TGP completed a project last year that replaced the portion of the Niagara Spur Loop Line subject to the aforementioned special permit. You were notified via email August 30, 2013, that excavation for the replacement had commenced. This portion of the line was replaced with pipe commensurate with the Class 3 location. The pipeline replacement was placed into service October 10, 2013. Consequently, TGP is notifying you herewith that there is no longer a need for the special permit and is requesting its cancellation.
