Dear Mr. Buchler:

On March 7, 2014, Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company, L.L.C. (TGP) wrote to the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA), requesting the cancellation of Special Permit PHMSA-2006-26618; originally issued to TGP on March 6, 2008, and further amended on May 30, 2012, for the Niagara Spur Line 230B-200 natural gas transmission pipeline system located in Niagara County, New York. Additional information about the replacement and pressure testing of the pipeline segment was requested of TGP and received by PHMSA in a letter dated August 13, 2014.

Effective, August 19, 2014, PHMSA hereby cancels special permit PHMSA-2006-26618. This cancellation is based upon TGP's request to PHMSA and information furnished on pipe replacement and pressure tests conducted and completed by TGP on October 10, 2013. TGP will be required to comply with all sections for 49 CFR, Part 192 in the operating of the Niagara Spur Line 230B-200.
