Re: Modification--Request to Withdraw Special Permit Segments

Dear Mr. Goodwin:

The Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) has reviewed your revised letter of October 19, 2012, in which Texas Gas Transmission, LLC, (TXGT), requested that the following three segments, be removed from the special permit:

PHMSA has no objections to the removal of these segments from PHMSA-2008-0067. Therefore, TXGT must comply with the requirements of Part 192 when operating these segments.

The requirements and conditions of the special permit continue to apply to the Fayette Lateral pipeline segment (a 166.2-mile, 36-inch natural gas transmission pipeline that runs from Conway County, Arkansas, easterly to Coahoma County, Mississippi) listed in the special permit.
