RE: CPF 3-2022-074-CAO - ITEM 2 - OPERATING PRESSURE RESTRICTION

Mr. Ochs,

TC Energy, on behalf of its subsidiary, TC Oil Pipeline Operations, Inc., has received the Corrective Action Order CPF 3-2022-0074-CAO dated December 8th, 2022. In accordance with the CAO Item 2(b) Operating Pressure Restriction, requires that within 15 days of receipt of the CAO, TC Oil must provide the Director the actual operating pressures of each pump station on the Affected Segment at the time of failure and the reduced pressure restriction set-points at these same locations. In response, the operating pressure at Steele City Pump Station at the time of the failure was 1153 psig. The reduced pressure setting at Steele City Pump Station is now 923 psig.
