Dear Mr. Mayberry:

On August 4, 2022, PHMSA granted a special permit (Docket No. PHMSA-2020-0005) waiving compliance of 49 CFR 192.611(a) and (d), 192.619(a), and 192.5 for two (2) segments, KM Segments 551 and 552. CIG appreciates PHMSA's consideration and grant of Special Permit PHMSA-2020-0005.

Rather than implementing the conditions of special permit (Docket No. PHMSA-2020-0005), CIG has chosen to replace the special permit segments. These replacement projects were completed and returned to service July 24, 2023. CIG no longer requests that compliance with 49 CFR 192.611(a) and (d), 192.619(a), and 192.5 be waived on KM Segments 551 and 552. Condition 18 of PHMSA-2020-0005 requires the submittal of an executive certification within 12 months of the grant of the special permit. CIG is hereby requesting that PHSMA-2020-0005 be closed and withdrawn in lieu of submittal of the executive certification.
