RE: Docket No. PHMSA-2008-0141 Special Permit Abrogation/Discontinuation Request,
14-inch Sioux Falls Main Line (SDM90201)

Effective April 15, 2010, and renewed April 7, 2015, and April 15, 2020, the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration issued Northern Natural Gas a Special Permit per Docket No. PHMSA-2008-0141 waiving compliance with 49 CFR 192.625(b)(1) regarding odorization of one segment of the Northern Natural Gas transmission pipeline system located in Lincoln County, South Dakota. The pipeline safety regulations in §192.625(b)(1) require natural gas pipeline operators to odorize natural gas in pipelines when at least 50% of the line downstream from an area located in a Class 3 or Class 4 location as defined in §192.5, Class Locations.

The special permit segment is located on the 14-inch Sioux Falls Main Line (SDM90201). Since the special permit was granted, pipeline system conditions have changed, and Northern Natural Gas odorizes the section of the line as defined in §192.625(b)(1).

Northern Natural Gas requests the abrogation and discontinuation of active special permit Docket No. PHMSA-2008-0141 as the 14-inch Sioux Falls Main Line (SDM90201) complies with 49 CFR §192.625.
