Proclamation

WHEREAS: Damage caused by unsafe digging can have undesired consequences, including service

interruption, damage to the environment, personal injury, and even death; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota's underground facilities are jeopardized by unintentional damage when

people do not call 811 to locate underground lines prior to digging; and

WHEREAS: The Call 811 Before You Dig campaign provides professional excavators and homeowners

with a simple way to request underground utility line locations; and

WHEREAS: Minnesotans can stay safe and connected by making a simple call to 811 or visiting

GopherStateOneCall.com in advance of any digging project; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota's underground facilities are jeopardized by unintentional damage when

people do not use the information resources available to locate underground lines prior

to digging; and

WHEREAS: It's recommended to wait 48 hours before beginning a digging project and always respect

boundaries made by marked lines for the safety of you and others; and

WHEREAS: Homeowners can protect their time, money, and health by learning about safe digging

practices or by relying on the expertise of professional excavators to ensure safety for

themselves and their neighborhood.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TIM WALZ, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 2024 as:

SAFE DIGGING MONTH

in the State of Minnesota.
