2016-2018 HMEP Offset Process

Process To Determine Offset

- Reviewed Year 1 Annual FFR.
- Funding for year 1 must have been obligated on FFR.
- Lines e and f were acceptable to have amounts.
- Line h could not have a balance.
- Grantee was offset for the year 3 award by the amount reflected in Line h of their FFR.





2016-2018 HMEP Offset Process

How Supplemental Funding Worked

- The offset funding was pooled together for supplemental funding for HMEP grantees that met the following criteria:
 - Submitted all for FY16-18 reports on time.
 - Expended all of year 1 funds. Did not look at what the FFR stated, but expenditure reports from Delphi.
- Grantees eligible to apply for the supplemental funding notified via email.





2016-2018 HMEP Offset Process

How Supplemental Funding Worked

- Grantees eligible to apply for the supplemental funding notified via email of their eligibility along with the amount available.
- Grantees had to submit a supplemental application along with a year 3 continuing application.
- Supplemental funding applications went through the same review process as continuing applications.
- If application was recommended, supplemental funding was added to the award amount for their year 3 application.





Strategy for Reimplementation of Offset









HMEP 2025-2027 Offset Proposed Strategy

- Offset based on extensions and remaining balance of FY22-24 award remaining balances not SF425 reports.
- Only year two allocation amount would be offset.
- Criteria eligibility for supplemental funding:
 - 1. Low and Medium risk level
 - 2. Submission of FY22-24 progress reports and Federal Financial Reports on time.
 - 3. Less than 10% of funding remaining of FY22-24 award.
