Dear Mr. Mayberry:

On April 11, 2022, PHMSA granted a special permit (Docket No. PHMSA-2016-0158) waiving compliance with 49 CFR 192.611(a) and (d), 192.619(a), and 192.5 for four segments: KM Segments 404, 418, 419, and 420. TGP appreciates PHMSA's consideration and the granting of Special Permit PHMSA-2016-0158.

KM Segment 404 was replaced on August 28, 2024. Additionally, KM Segments 418, 419, and 420 have been reclassified from Class 3 to Class 1 due to their transition to non-habitable structures. Consequently, TGP no longer requires the previously granted waiver for compliance with 49 CFR 192.611(a) and (d), 192.619(a), and 192.5 for the aforementioned segments. TGP respectfully requests the resolution and closure of PHMSA-2016-0158.
