WHEREAS:	Damage caused by unsafe digging can have undesired consequences, including service interruption, damage to the environment, personal injury, and even death; and
WHEREAS:	People in Minnesota can stay safe and connected by making a simple call to 811 or visiting GopherStateOneCall.com in advance of any digging project; and
WHEREAS:	The Call 811 Before You Dig campaign provides professional excavators and homeowners a simple way to request underground utility line locations; and
WHEREAS:	Minnesota's underground facilities are jeopardized by unintentional damage when people do not call 811 to locate underground lines prior to digging; and
WHEREAS:	State law requires advance notice of 48 hours to Gopher State One Call before beginning a digging project; and
WHEREAS:	Homeowners can protect their time, money, and health by learning about safe digging practices or by relying on the expertise of professional excavators to ensure safety for themselves and their neighborhood; and
WHEREAS:	Waiting for the "work to begin" date and time before digging, respecting the marked lines, and digging with care around marked lines are the basic elements of 811's message of "Safety is in your hands. Every Dig. Every time."

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TIM WALZ, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 2025 as:

SAFE DIGGING MONTH

in the State of Minnesota.
