Notice of Extension of Time To File
Comments

On February 16, 1968, the Hazardous Materials Regulations Board issued a notice of proposed rule making (33 F.R. 3382) proposing several amendments to the hazardous materials regulations of the Department of Transportation. That notice stated that all comments received before May 1, 1968, would be considered by the Board before taking final action on the notice.

The Board has received several requests for additional time to comment on certain portions of the notice, particularly the proposals relating to the

definition of flammable liquids and the transportation of liquefied gases in the lower temperature ranges. Since these proposals are complicated and more controversial than other parts of the notice, the Board has decided to extend the comment period thereon to September 5, 1968.

Extension of time to comment on these portions of Notice No. 68-2 does not commit the Board to withhold final action on the remaining portions of that notice.
